


Catch and Release Policy

No fish may be taken home regardless of size. Enjoy eating fish under the legal slot size and possession limit during your stay at the lake. Barbless hooks are encouraged. Eating sizes while at the lake include:

- · Walleye under 18 inches.
- Northern Pike under 27 inches.


Important Information

We will fly you from Ear Falls to Shabu Wilderness Outposts (approximately 60 air miles) on a Twin Beech 18 or Cessna 180. Due to aircraft weight restrictions each guest will be allowed a maximum of 90lbs. of luggage (including beverages and groceries). Pack food in small cardboard boxes and clothes in duffel bags NOT TO EXCEED 50lbs. each. (Please no large coolers or containers). Do not bring what you do not need. Guests will be charged for overweight baggage. Please do not bring rifles or shotguns out of season. Do not bring handguns at any time.

Shabumeni Lake Ear Falls, Ontario

Come experience Shabumeni Lake and fly-in wilderness fishing at it's best at Shabu Wilderness Outposts, located approximately 60 miles north east of Ear Falls, Ontario. Shabumeni Lake is 13 miles long with two inlet rivers and one outlet river that provide you with great early season fishing. Along with countless bays and islands are numerous deep water reefs for excellent warm weather fishing.

The outpost is situated on a hill overlooking the pristine beauty of Shabumeni Lake and can accommodate up to 12 people. The camp has solar powered lights with hot and cold running water, showers, gas BBQ grill, propane fish cooker, wood burning stove, propane cooking stove, propane refrigerator and a fully equipped kitchen. The outpost also has an emergency generator, screenedin fish cleaning shed with running water, a large deck, boats/motors and everything you'll need to have a great wilderness fishing experience.
